

F-1 Student I-20 Program Extension Application

The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) allows students in the F-1 immigration status to apply for a Program Extension under certain circumstances. According to section 214.2(f)(7)(iii) of the Code of Federal Regulations regarding nonimmigrant classes, the Designated School Official can approve an Extension of Stay only after certifying that the student has "continually maintained status and that the delays are caused by compelling academic or medical reason, such as changes of major or research topics, unexpected research problems, or documented illnesses. Delays caused by academic probation or suspension are not acceptable reasons for program extension."

If you anticipate that you will not be able to complete your degree by the I-20 expiration/program end-date, which is listed in Section #5 of your I-20, you will need to submit the required documents listed on the back of this page <u>at least 1 month</u> <u>BEFORE your current I-20 expiration/program end-date.</u> Students who fail to submit the required paperwork by the established deadline may fall out of lawful immigration status and may need to apply for a reinstatement to lawful F-1status. *Special Note:* Because of the time it takes to prepare this application, F-1 students are advised to begin preparing it at least 2-3 months prior to their current I-20 expiration date.

Application Instructions for the F-1 Student I-20 Program Extension

F-1 students applying for an I-20 program extension MUST read and follow the instructions below and submit all required documents to the Office of International Student Services (OISS) <u>at least 1 month prior</u> to the expiration/program end-date listed in Section #5 of your current I-20. Failure to meet this deadline could result in the loss of your lawful F-1 immigration status and ability to complete your degree at Regent.

- 1. Complete Part A of the form entitled <u>"Academic Department Recommendation for an Extension of Stay/I-20 Extension"</u>, and have your Academic Advisor/Dean complete Part B of the form (attached).
- 2. Obtain new Financial Documentation for your new I-20 and submit a new <u>Financial Certification Form</u>.

You will need to meet with the OISS Director to determine the exact amount of funding you will need to show for your program extension period. The amount will vary depending on how long you will need to complete your degree and where you are in your academic program. 3. Obtain a <u>Certificate of Enrollment</u> from the Registrar's Office.

The Certificate of Enrollment must show full-time or part-time status for <u>every semester</u> since you began your studies at Regent University—including the current semester. (The Certificate must be requested from the Registrar's Office in Room 235, Student Center and takes approximately 3-5 days to process.)

- 4. Complete the <u>Student Verification of Lawful F-1 Immigration Status</u> (attached).
- 5. Submit all items listed above to the Office of International Student Services (OISS) with a <u>photocopy of your most recent I-20</u>; the <u>essential</u> pages of your passport; your I-94card; and your latest F-1visa.

► Failure to submit all documents by the above listed deadline can result in serious immigration problems for you and the inability to complete your degree program at Regent.
