

Course Map: Doctor of Strategic Leadership

DSL students must complete a total of 51 credit hours, within 7 years:

- 36 credit hours of core courses
- 9 credit hours of concentration elective courses
- 6 credit hours of final doctoral project courses

DSL students must attend 2 required residencies:

- Residency 1 is associated with LDSL 722 (3)
- Residency 2 is associated with LDSL 727 (3)
