9 hours of research related credit

15 hours of dissertation research credit

Present an acceptable research-based dissertation

Notes

- $_{\rm 1}$ Post-master's and doctoral Education students will take UNIV LIB if they score a 6 on the criterion admissions writing sample. If students do not score a 6, they must enroll in EDU 600 their first semester of post-master's coursework.
- $_{\rm 2}$ Choose five courses (15 credits) from any of the current Ed.S./Ed.D. concentration courses.
- ₃ If any of the above courses were taken as part of the concentration curriculum, the credit earned will not count toward the 9 additional hours required for the Ph.D. The balance of hourse needed to satisfy the 9 hour requirement shall result in enrolling in EFND 790 Independent Study with a SOE professor. These independent study hours shall be used to focus on research collaboration in the faculty member's are of interest.
- ⁴Students who have not defended their dissertation after completing EFND 906A, B, & C are required to take EFND 907 Dissertation Continuation (3 credits) each term until either they successfully defend or their time limit has been reached.
