

Request for Waiver – English Language Proficiency Exam

All students enrolled at Regent University are required to be proficient in the English language. For international students in which English is not the primary language of their country, either the TOEFL, PTE Academic or IELTS exam must be taken to demonstrate one's effectiveness with the English language. The required English language proficiency exam may be waived if an applicant's native language is English, he or she has received at least 2 years of education from an institution where English was the language of instruction, or he or she has graduated from an educational institution within the United States.
